REMINDERS

Lateral flow testing is available at several sites across the City— including the Civic Centre and Pendeford library. Lateral flow tests are a good way of identifying anyone with Covid who does not have symptoms.

The idea of this is that everyone testing positive then self-isolates to ensure that they do not unknowingly pass it on to anyone else. Twice weekly tests are recommended, they are free and do not need to be booked.

Welcome back to Owls class who have finished their self- isolation this week. Covid rates in the City are currently estimated at around 1 in 45 people and this reflects in school. Please be very cautious about your health and look for Covid signs in yourself and your children.
